Gongsanseong Fortress is worth the visit for its historical and cultural significance, and also for the beautiful view Geumgang riverside and the castle's trail. Baekje Cultural Land, built over a period of 17 years, is nestled in Gyuam-myeon, Buyeo-gun, Chungcheongnam-do, providing a home to Baekje's Cultural Heritages.

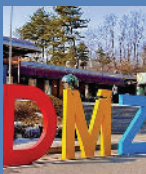

DMZ 3rd Tunnel & Dora Observatory

Explore the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), including Imjingak Park, where there are many statues and monuments regarding the Korean War; 3rd Infiltration Tunnel, which is one of four known tunnels under the border between North Korea and South Korea; and Dora Observatory, where you can see the North Korean territory through binoculars from the 304 square feet.

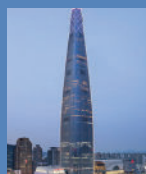


Starfield Anseong is the largest shopping complex in the region and offers over 300 shops, including 70 eateries, Aquafield, Sports Monster, and Cinema.

Lotte World Tower Seoul Sky & Aquarium

The Seoul Sky Observatory is located at the top of the Lotte World Tower, the world's fifth tallest building standing 123 stories and 555 meters high. Discover more than 55,000 marine animals from around 650 species at Lotte World Aquarium.

Suncheon Bay National Garden

The Suncheon Bay National Garden was established in order to turn 1.12 square kilometers of natural habitat in to a conservation area where it houses over 505 species of trees and 113 species of flowers. The numerous groups of tulips and royal azaleas are truly a sight to see.

Sacheon Ocean Cable Car & German Village

The 2.43km cable car provides stunning views of the ocean and mountains on a 25 minute ride. Then take a stroll through a German village, surrounded by forests and the sea.

Hwaseong Fortress & UN Forces First Battle Memorial

Hwaseong Fortress is an impressive structure from the latter part of the Joseong Dynasty (1392-1910) and the official fortress of Suwon City. The fortress (constructed from 1794 to 1796) was built as a show of the King's filial piety towards his father Jangheonseja and to build a new pioneer city with its own economic power.
