









### **SEOUL LANTERN FESTIVAL 2025**

**Sat, 11 Jan, 1400-2400** (3-hr bus ride) **\$60** per person

Seoul Lantern Festival is a night light festival displaying hundreds of LED lights and lanterns made of traditional Korean paper with Seoul's theme in Cheonggye Plaza and the area of Cheonggyecheon Stream.

## DAEGU E-WORLD STARLIGHT FESTIVAL

**Sat, 18 Jan, 1200-2400** (3-hr bus ride) **\$90** per person

Enjoy the starlight festival while exploring over 30 rides in the Daegu's representative theme park, E-World, is decorated with 10 million light bulbs and appreciate the beautiful night view of the city from 83 Tower.

# STRAWBERRY PICKING, WINE TASTING & FORTRESS

**Sun, 19 Jan, 0830-1700** (1.5-hr bus ride) **\$70** per person

You can enjoy experiences of strawberry picking, wine tasting and botting of wine (bottle filling, corking, and labeling). The fortress is the most intact fortress in Korea and a historically significant site built around 600 years ago.

## JEONJU HANOK VILLAGE & TAP-SA TEMPLE

**Sat, 25 Jan, 0900-1600** (1.5-hr bus ride) **\$40** per person

Hanok Village is located in the city of Jeonju and there are over 800 traditional Korean "Hanok" houses. Explore Maisan Provincial Park, a sacred site filled with stone pagodas and one of the best country parks in South Korea.

# YESAN APPLE WINERY & SUDEOK-SA TEMPLE

**Sat, 26 Jan, 0830-1730** (2.5-hr bus ride) **\$60** per person

Enjoy a wine tasting and apple pie making experience! Yesan apple are famous nationwide for their beautiful color and great taste. The Sudeoksa Temple, which has plyed an important role in the history of Korea's Buddism.



### **DMZ 3RD TUNNEL & DORA OBSERVATORY**

**Sat, 1 Feb, 0700-2000** (3.5-hr bus ride) **\$75** per person (Sign-up by 27 Jan, 1700)

Explore the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), including Imjingak Park, where there are many statues and monuments regarding the Korean War; 3rd Infiltration Tunnel, which is one of four known tunnels under the border between North Korea and South Korea; and Dora Observatory, where you can see the North Korean territory through binoculars from the 304 square feet.
