### 6. Boseong Green Tea Plantation & Folk Village

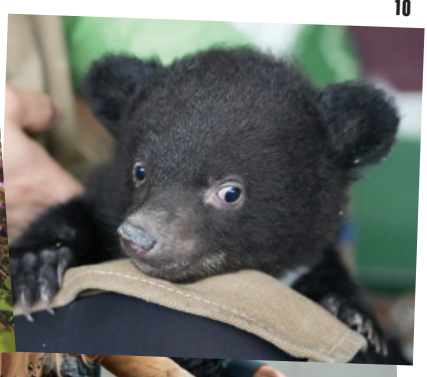
Sun, 24 May, 0730-1830 (2.5-hr bus ride)
